Who Should Apply?

The course is designed with an innovative perspective, with practical scenarios of great added value for tenured Lean Six Sigma Black Belts. The course also has rigorous academic requirements, so it is necessary that students meet the following criteria before enrolling:

- Certified Black Belt from OpusWorks Institute or similar institution with alignment to ASQ's BOK
- Project portfolio: At least 5 projects in portfolio including corresponding affidavits.
 - 2 of these projects will be selected for review and the students will need to prepare for a Q&A session with our review board about the two projects selected.
- At least 4 years of demonstrable experience as certified Black Belt in the following criteria:
 - Teaching, coaching and mentoring projects.
 - Technical experience in the use of LSS BB BOK.
 - Leading Lean Six Sigma at mid or senior level.
 - Score at least 80% in the OpusWorks Master Black Belt pre-enrollment exam.
